Introduction Charlton Farm

Charlton Park Estate Farm spans an impressive 1,454 hectares, integrating arable cropping, grassland, and environmental landscapes. Our mission is to optimize land use while enhancing environmental sustainability and soil health.



Farming Practices

Our farm employs diverse agricultural methods:

- Arable Cropping: 1,200 hectares of predominantly grade 3 land with varied soil types, including gault clay, oolitic limestone, and cornbrash. We utilize minimum tillage and direct drilling to reduce costs and improve crop establishment.
- Grain Storage: We boast a substantial grain storage facility with a 40-tonne-per-hour dryer, a grain dresser, and over 5,500 tonnes of storage capacity. This enables us to store, clean, and dry both our own and third-party grain.

Stewardship Scheme :

For over 20 years, we have managed 78 hectares of woodland and 560 hectares of environmental features, including wild bird food areas, cover crops, wildflower zones, and grass margins, to support declining wild bird populations.



Grazing Land:

Large areas of grassland are leased annually to local businesses and horse owners, supporting the local community.

Anaerobic Digestion (AD)

Our farm features a third-party Anaerobic Digestion plant:

Biogas Production

The plant processes food waste and crops like maize, rye, and grass into biogas, which is cleaned and injected into the national gas grid as biomethane.

Fertilizer Production

The digestate byproduct serves as agricultural fertilizer, enhancing soil fertility for future crops.

Green Energy

Charlton Biogas provides the greenest gas possible, contributing to a more sustainable local energy supply.
